1. Perform intake assessment and assignment, advocacy, crisis intervention and systems navigation to individuals, groups and the community.
2. Assist in client crisis intervention and suicide intervention
3. Strong knowledge of the social determinants of health and issues that affect racialized communities
4. Facilitate client referral for internal and external social, financial, and institutional resources
5. Assist clients and the community to build support networks
6. Ensures that required documentation is completed and available in the client's health record in a timely manner that meets professional standards of practice
7. Coordinate/ participate in chart reviews, case conferencing and quality improvement initiatives
8. Participate in the development, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of knowledge sharing and health promotion programs and services for individuals, groups and the community
9. Perform other duties as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Bachelor's degree in a relevant discipline from a recognized university or equivalent certification in a recognized social service worker program
2. Three to five years relevant or equivalent experience in a community setting.
3. Proficiency in current assessment, counselling, case management and crisis intervention techniques
4. Experience in program development, implementation, monitoring and evaluation
5. Knowledge of women's health issues
6. In addition to English, knowledge of a language spoken within one of the four priority communities, an asset
