Project Summary:

This project will lead the establishment of a CIHR HIV Prevention Research Centre. The proposed national centre will focus on social research that informs prevention and intervention efforts, and will bridge the divide between NGOs / community-based organizations that are primarily responsible for developing and implementing interventions and researchers who conduct the research and evaluations. Each year, the Centre will develop 2-3 research protocols on topics such as the effects of HIV criminalization; addressing social determinants of health in outreach and prevention work; stigma and determinant of HIV risk within specific subpopulations and within specific context/settings; positive prevention; informing prevention / interventions through the experiences of sero-discordant couples; and resiliency factors in specific subpopulations.
