The aim(s) of this pilot project are: a) to develop and implement an HIV education and training module that will enhance the knowledge and skills of Children Aid Society staff and social work students across Ontario when working with children and families living with and affected by HIV; b) to establish dialogue between families living with and affected by HIV and CAS agencies to shape ongoing collaborative training, practice and policy initiatives; and c) to enable the voices of CAS service users, particularly Aboriginal and African, Caribbean and Black families living with and affected by HIV, to shape ongoing training, practice and policy initiatives in ways that respond to their unique historical and current day realities.
