Project Summary:

The aim of this study is to evaluate the applicability of wHEALTH intervention in a web-based format. We will: a) evaluate the effectiveness and acceptability of the online intervention comparing with the face-to-face model used in the initial wHEALTH Intervention study; b) enhance our understanding of HIV-related stigma as a barrier to WLH to seeking social support; and c) provide insight regarding matching of Peer Case Managers and participants during the intervention
